COVID

No changes to Boris' "Steps out" have been announced to date (19 March) so if all goes according to his plan we should **ALL** be able to meet in the Moose Hall on Saturday 26th June.

Hopefully we can get the Board of Officers and Ladies Committee together before that date.

Steps 1 and 2 below

A summary of the steps to May 17th if things go according to Boris' plan.

From 29 March, outdoor gatherings (including in private gardens) of either 6 people (the Rule of 6) or 2 households will also be allowed, making it easier for friends and families to meet outside. Outdoor sports facilities open. Travel if necessary and no holiday travel.

Step 2, which will be no earlier than 12 April, opening of hairdressers and nail salons; and public buildings, including libraries and community centres. Indoor leisure facilities such as gyms will also reopen (but only for use by people on their own or in household groups); as will most outdoor attractions and settings including outdoor hospitality venues, zoos, theme parks, and drive-in cinemas. Self-contained accommodation such as campsites and holiday lets, where indoor facilities are not shared with other households, can also reopen.

Hospitality venues will be allowed to serve people outdoors at Step 2 and there will be no need for customers to order a substantial meal with alcoholic drinks and no curfew, although customers must order, eat and drink while seated ('table service').
